President Report - Nov 25, 2024

Becky has been very helpful. She has organized an order for club swimsuits and got a great rate, same as last year and they are being sent to NAC for pickup soon. Becky has also sent out two separate swag order emails, with the second one to get orders for club gear including hoodies and sweats, etc. We are discussing doing a parents line but that has yet to be confirmed.

Additionally, I reached out to Heath who is responsible for the pool operations, I wanted to learn more about potential closures as I have read in the news that Ravensong is getting a planned expansion, here is his reply:

"We are going through a process currently preparing for the referendum for the borrowing for the purpose of an expansion to Ravensong Aquatic Centre. This will include public engagement and information sessions in the Spring 2025.

In a nutshell, there has not been a finalized referendum date set (awaiting Provincial approval) but are anticipating in early Spring 2025. The referendum will be held for the public to vote on whether the RDN should move forward with the borrowing of \$30 million dollars for the purpose of an expansion to the Ravensong Aquatic Centre (architect concept drawings are on the GetInvolved.rdn.ca site but includes another pool tank). If approved, the expansion would see construction in 2026/2027 with anticipated completion in 2027. The construction planning would see limited required shutdowns to help minimize service disruption."

In the short term, this is not something we need to be concerned with at all. Even if and when it gets approved, the expansion will be done to minimize disruption to services.

Future things to discuss, the winter social which I am unable to help with much as I am away and Ari and I will not be attending. We chatted about AquaGo! Kids doing a fun bring-a- friend night just before the break, we need to confirm that and begin to promote that. Are we limiting that to just AquaGo! kids?
