NEW BUSINESS:

- a. Jenny has a line on a Mitchell's soup fundraiser as well as a Gunter Bros meats fundraiser.

- g. Updated Fee Structure: Jessica presented the updated fee structure. Julie moved to accept the new fee structure, Krystal accepts, nobody opposed.
- h. RDN Grant- Julie asked for some ideas for the RDN grant. Equipment such as yoga blocks, exercise bands, inversion trainer and sound system were all put forward as suggestions. **ACTION: Julie to apply for the grant.**
- i. Jessica mentioned that the Rotary club may have some volunteer opportunities and wonders if there is interest from parents to join them as volunteers. There is interest. **ACTION- Jessica to ask her contact for more information**
